A Programs Administered by FAA - Cash Assistance (CA) - Overview

REVISION 48 (01/01/20 - 12/31/20)

The purpose of the CA program is to provide temporary cash assistance and <u>supportive services</u> to eligible participants in the following groups:

- Parents or specified relatives with dependent children under age 19 who are in their care
- Parents of a child who receives SSI
- <u>CA Foster Care (FC)</u>
- Refugee Resettlement Program
- Two-Parent Employment Program

FAA is responsible for determining CA eligibility and eligibility for some Tribal TANF programs.

When CA participants have the potential to become self-supporting with a onetime payment, <u>Grant Diversion</u> must be offered as an option. All CA applications are screened for potential Grant Diversion eligibility.

The Grant Diversion Script and Applicant Agreement (FAA-1410A) form or the GD Applicant Agreement and Script (A029) notice must be completed, even when the participant declines the Grant Diversion option.
