A Programs Administered by FAA - Cash Assistance (CA) -Overview

REVISION 14 (10/01/10 -12/31/10)

The purpose of the CA program is to provide temporary cash assistance and <u>supportive services</u> to eligible participants in the following groups:

- Parents or specified relatives with dependent children under age 19 who are in their care
- Parents of a child who receives SSI
- <u>CA Foster Care (FC)</u>
- <u>Refugee Resettlement Program</u>
- <u>Two-Parent Employment Program</u>

FAA is responsible for determining CA eligibility and eligibility for some <u>Tribal TANF programs</u>.

When CA participants have the potential to become self-supporting with a onetime payment, <u>Grant Diversion</u> may be offered as an option. CA applications are screened for potential Grant Diversion eligibility.
