## F BG01 General Unemployment Insurance Developmental Effort (GUIDE) - Overview

GUIDE is used by the following FAA staff ONLY:

- Overpayment Writers
- Fair Hearing Specialists

Using the SSN the participant is working under, inquire on the participant as follows:

- To display a different screen for the same SSN, key the transaction option number in the TRANSACTION OPTION field, and press ENTER.
- To display the same screen for a different SSN, key the other SSN in the SSN field, and press ENTER.
