.02 New Applications - Expedited Applications - Eligibility for Expedited Services

The following applicants are eligible for NA expedited services:

- Applicants whose liquid resources do not exceed \$100, and who anticipate receiving less than \$150 gross countable income in the month of application.
- Destitute <u>migrant or seasonal farm workers</u> whose liquid resources do not exceed \$100.
- Applicants whose combined actual gross income and liquid resources are less than their monthly <u>shelter costs</u> and <u>utility</u> <u>expenses</u>.

Applicants are eligible for NA expedited services only when the application is filed outside an existing NA approval period.

There is no limit to the number of times applicants can be approved under expedited procedures as long as prior to each expedited approval either of the following occurs:

- The applicant completes the verification requirements that were postponed at the last expedited approval. (See <u>Postponed Verification</u>)
- The applicant was approved under normal processing standards since the last expedited approval.

WARNING

Applicants are NOT potentially eligible for NA expedited services when they are NOT eligible for benefits for the month of application. The application must be processed according to <u>new application</u> <u>time frames</u>.

ABAWD participants are eligible for NA expedited services when they meet any of the following requirements:

- Have not received <u>three countable months</u>
- Meet <u>ABAWD work requirements</u> or <u>ABAWD exemptions</u>
