The Benefit Payment History screen displays payment information about each check that has been issued past and present.

The status of the UI payment is indicated by the code in the PAY TYPE field. Situations affecting the claimant's eligibility must be resolved with UI before a check can be issued. When an adjustment or determination changes the status of the pay type for the week, the code is updated. This can cause pay types to vary during the week.

This screen also displays the date the check is processed. The UI check is mailed the next postal work day following the date the check is processed. Benefits are considered to be received by a participant on the third postal work day following the date benefits are mailed.

NOTE Postal work days are Monday through Saturday, with the exception of federal holidays, in most areas. (See Example 07)

Press F2 to view more Benefit Payment History screens when there are more than 12 payments.

Key X next to the benefit week end date in the BWE field and press F6 to display the <u>13 Benefit Payment Information</u> screen for the BWE selected.
