A Documented Verification

Documents are the primary source of verification. Documented verification is written evidence (also known as hard copy) originating from any of the following:

- An agency
- Organization
- Individual qualified to have knowledge of the required information

Key HC in the verification field when documented verification is used.

Ask the PI for names of <u>collateral contacts</u> when one of the following occurs:

- Documented verification is not readily available.
- Documented verification is not available within required time frames.
