## 06 Required Documentation

REVISION 38 (10/01/15 - 11/30/15)

Documentation must support determinations of eligibility and benefit level. Documentation must contain sufficient detail to allow a reviewer to decide that the determination is reasonable and accurate.

Written documentation must be clear and concise and placed in the <u>case file(g)</u>.

The following are examples of where documentation may be written or keyed:

- AZTECS screens that allow documentation including, but not limited to, the Case Documentation Screen (CADO)
- Health-e-Arizona Plus screens that allow note entry including, but not limited to, Case Notes
- Program forms

NOTE FAA program forms are located in the document center.

## **EXCEPTION**

When unable to copy verification, see <u>visually viewed verification</u> for documentation requirements.

When written documentation is not readily available, verbal verification through a <u>collateral contact</u> may be used as a verification source. For more information on what to document, see <u>Required Documentation – Collateral Contact</u>.
