A CA Drug Test Requirement

REVISION 13 (07/01/10 -09/30/10)

Effective 11/24/09, Arizona law requires FAA to complete the following for all eligible CA participants age 18 or over coded IN on SEPA:

- Determine when there is <u>reasonable cause</u> to believe the participant engages in the use of <u>illegal drugs(g)</u>.
- When reasonable cause exists refer the eligible participant for the required drug test. (See <u>Drug Test Referral Procedure</u>)
- Disqualify the participant for 12 consecutive calendar months when they <u>test positive</u> for the use of illegal drugs.

NOTE This includes dependent children age 18 or over.

EXCEPTION

Required drug testing does not apply to Refugee Cash Assistance (RCA), Tribal TANF or Grant Diversion.

The CA participant must comply with the drug test policy requirements at application as follows:

- At new application when benefits are authorized.
- At renewal application when the interview is completed.
