B Reasonable Cause for Drug Use

FAA must determine whether there is reasonable cause to believe the participant engages in the use of <u>illegal drugs(g)</u>. In order to determine reasonable cause, complete the following actions at renewal interviews:

- Provide an Illegal Drug Use Statement (FAA-1415) form at face to face interview or send an Illegal Drug Use Statement (A002) notice to all adult participants age 18 or over coded IN on SEPA.
- Review government or law enforcement documents in the case record that contain information regarding illegal drug use by the participant within the past 30 days.

Reasonable cause exists when one of the following occurs:

- The completed Illegal Drug Use Statement contains one or more YES responses.
- Government or law enforcement documents indicate the use of illegal drugs within the past 30 days by the participant.
