

06 **Returned Mail Procedures**

Returned mail is considered [unclear information\(g\)](#). Returned mail with a forwarding address is not verification that a participant has moved, only that there has been a change of mailing address. (See [Verifying Reported Changes](#) for more information on when verification is required.)

When FAA receives undeliverable mail from the United States Postal Service (USPS), all returned envelopes with a forwarding address label are scanned and uploaded into OnBase.

When there is a forwarding address label from USPS on the envelope, AZTECS automatically completes **all** of the following:

- Updates the mailing address in AZTECS
- Scans and uploads the envelope into OnBase
- Sends an X006 notice and generates an RM ACTS Alert, when the budgetary unit is assigned to standard reporting

When there is a forwarding address label from the USPS on the envelope, ensure the mailing address in HEAplus and AZTECS is updated. (See [Keying Addresses on ADDR](#))
