C Temporary Out of State Address

REVISION 32 (10/01/14 - 11/30/14)

When a participant is temporarily residing out of state, policy and procedures regarding benefit issuance are specific to the program as follows:

- CA benefits may be issued when the participant is living at a temporary address out of state.
- NA When one or more NA participants in a budgetary unit are temporarily residing out of state, for at least 30 calendar days, remove the ineligible participants and redetermine benefits allowing for NOAA. (See Removing Participants)

EXCEPTION

When a <u>spouse(g)</u> in the budgetary unit is temporarily residing out of state and meets one of the following conditions, remove the spouse and redetermine benefits allowing for NOAA:

- The spouse has been temporarily out of state at least 30 calendar days.
- The spouse has established a permanent residence away from the family (e.g. an apartment or house, not a motel). A separate residence of a spouse requires verification of the spouse's residence.

When ALL participants in the NA budgetary unit are temporarily out of state for at least 30 calendar days, close the NA case allowing for NOAA.
