

## B Relationship Verification Documents

Documents used to verify relationship include the following:

- Acknowledgement of Paternity ([CS-127](#)) forms
- Adoption records
- **AHCCCS** Deemed Newborn Reports ([CR600](#))
- Artificial insemination records
- Baptismal records (when issued prior to age five)
- Bio Data Sheets provided by refugees
- Bureau of Vital Statistics records
- Census records
- Certificates of Indian Blood (CIB)
- Certified birth certificates
- Correspondences from an individual to the child, or to others about the child, referring to the child as the individual's own
- Court orders for [Kinship Foster Care](#)
- Court records
- Church records including statement from priest, etc.
- Dependency hearing or proceeding court documents for [Legal Permanent Guardianship](#) (LPG)
- Genetic testing results
- Government Agency Request for Copies of Birth and Death Records ([FAA-1214](#))
- Hospital or public records of birth
- Insurance policies
- Juvenile court records
- Marriage licenses
- Marriage licenses abstract
- Military records
- Minute entries for Kinship Foster Care
- Navajo Nation Marital Status and Family Profiles

- Outpatient care records maintained by a hospital, clinic, or doctor

**MA EXCEPTION**

A statement from a neutral third party, such as a friend, relative, or DES employee verifying the father's admission of paternity is acceptable verification of relationship for [1931](#).
