.01 CA PRA Notification

When a participant does not comply with a PRA requirement, a sanction is imposed.

Noncompliance notification occurs in one of the following ways:

- FAA receives a noncompliance E-Form from DCSE. FAA
 issues the <u>NOAA</u> to the noncompliant participant and imposes
 the sanction. (See Sanction Notices)
- FAA receives an ACTS alert generated by Jobs to impose a Jobs sanction. Jobs issues the NOAA to the noncompliant participant.
- The <u>CA DEAUTH PROG SANC ACTS alert</u> is generated monthly by AZTECS when rollover occurs and a budgetary unit has an ongoing sanction. (See <u>Imposing Ongoing CA</u> <u>Sanction</u>)
