## 06 CA Sanctions

When a participant fails to comply with any of the CA program requirements specified in the Personal Responsibility Agreement (FA-164), it may be necessary to sanction the CA case. See <a href="PRA">PRA</a> for detailed information on when progressive sanctions are imposed and a description of the specific penalties involved.

## **EXCEPTION**

This policy does not apply to the following programs:

- Tribal Native Employment Works (NEW) (See <u>Tribal NEW</u>
   <u>Sanctions</u> for specific policy regarding how to impose Tribal NEW sanctions)
- TPEP (See <u>TPEP Withholding</u> when the TPEP participant fails to comply with PRA requirements)
