G Residents of Institutions - NA

REVISION 49 (01/01/21 - 12/31/21)

Consider participants residents of an <u>institution(g)</u> when the facility they reside in meets both of the following requirements:

- Provides the majority of their meals (over 50% of three meals daily) as part of the institution's normal services.
- The institution is not authorized to accept NA benefits.

Only residents of the following institutions are potentially eligible to participate in the NA program:

- Federally subsidized housing for the elderly
- Drug and alcohol treatment centers
- Domestic violence emergency shelters
- Group Living Arrangement facilities
- Shelters for homeless persons

When a participant resides in an institution listed in the Institutions List in HEAplus, the participant is potentially eligible for NA benefits. When a participant resides in an institution not listed in HEAplus, see Maintaining Institutions in HEAplus.

When a participant resides in an ineligible institution, they are not qualified to participate in the NA program. When a participant resides in an ineligible institution, deny or stop NA using the RI Denial or Closure Reason Code.

Incarcerated participants are considered to be residing in jail. When an applicant or participant resides in a jail, deny or stop NA using the RJ Denial or Closure Reason Code.
