When a shelter has met the definition of a domestic violence emergency shelter, the residents of that shelter are not considered residents of an institution and may be eligible for NA benefits. (See <u>Shelter Qualification Requirements</u>)

The region office determines when the domestic violence emergency shelter definition is met.

When Region Office has determined a shelter has met the definition of domestic violence emergency shelter, the shelter is listed in HEAplus. When a shelter is not listed in HEAplus, see <u>Maintaining</u> <u>Institutions in HEAplus</u>.

A woman or a man who enters a shelter may have changed their Social Security number or name. When this is discovered, see <u>Enumeration Overview</u>.
