## A Qualified Noncitizens

## **REVISION 36**

(06/01/15 – 07/31/15) A qualified noncitizen is an individual lawfully residing in the U.S. with a classification status that allows potential eligibility for NA and CA.

Qualified noncitizens have either a temporary qualified status or a permanent qualified status.

The following noncitizens have a temporary qualified status:

- <u>Asylee</u>
- Battered Noncitizen
- <u>Cuban or Haitian Entrant</u>
- Deportation Withheld
- Indefinite Detainee
- <u>Parolee</u>
- Refugee or Amerasian
- Severe Trafficking Victim
- Special Immigrant Visa Holder

The following noncitizens have a permanent qualified status:

- Lawful Permanent Residents (LPRs)
- American Indians Born Outside of the United States

Hmong and Highland Laotians

NOTE Most LPR's come to the U.S. in a temporary status. A noncitizen that enters the U.S. as an LPR is usually sponsored.
