.02 Expedited Health-e-Arizona Applications

One-e-App sets expedited time frames for applications screened as potentially eligible for expedited services. These applications are highlighted in RED on the <u>UNASSIGNED APPLICATIONS screen</u> and the <u>ASSIGNED APPLICATIONS screen</u>. The reasons for expediting the application display in the HIGH PRIORITY column.

One-e-App sets expedited time frames and displays the appropriate expedite reason type, when any of the following occurs:

- TPEP A CA application is identified as eligible for <u>TPEP</u> (five calendar days). AZTECS DOES NOT automatically register as an expedited application.
- KINSHIP A CA application is identified as eligible for <u>Kinship</u>
 <u>Care</u> (five <u>workdays(g)</u>). AZTECS automatically registers as
 an expedited application.
- EMG FS An NA applicant is identified as eligible for <u>NA</u>
 <u>expedited services</u> (seven calendar days). AZTECS
 automatically registers as an expedited application.
- PREGNANT An MA applicant is keyed as <u>pregnant</u> (20 calendar days). AZTECS automatically registers as an expedited application.
- INPATIENT An MA applicant is keyed as <u>hospitalized</u> (seven calendar days). (See <u>Expedited MA Services</u>) AZTECS automatically registers as an expedited application.
- SEE NOTES The intake facility manually submitted the application as HIGH PRIORITY. The reason is keyed in the NOTES, and displays on the <u>APPLICATION DETAILS screen</u> and the Application Summary. AZTECS DOES NOT automatically register as an expedited application.

WARNING

When a facility submits an application as HIGH PRIORITY, determine whether the application meets the criteria for expedited services. When the application does not meet the criteria for expedited services, complete the eligibility determination using standard time frames.
