A KidsCare AHCCCS Responsibilities

REVISION 05 (07/01/08 – 09/30/08)

The AHCCCS KidsCare staff is responsible for the following:

- Screening all applications for potential <u>Title XIX MA</u> eligibility.
- Requesting all information necessary to complete and determine <u>Title XXI (KidsCare)</u> eligibility for all new and renewal applications.
- Referring the following to FAA:
 Applications for potentially eligible Title XIX participants
 Any verification they obtained for the KidsCare determination
 (See KidsCare FAA Local Office Responsibilities)

Applications requiring a Title XIX determination are routed by AHCCCS to FAA as follows:

New MA applications are automatically registered in AZTECS to the Research and Analysis (R&A) Unit site code. This is completed through an interface between the ACE(a) system and AZTECS. The information from the application is autopopulated into AZTECS. (See R&A KidsCare MA Referrals)

The date of application is the original date on the KidsCare application.

EXCEPTION

One-e-App Health-e-Arizona submits new MA applications simultaneously to both FAA and AHCCCS when the application includes ALL of the following applicants:

- An adult applicant who screens potentially eligible, and is applying, for Title XIX MA
- An applicant who screens potentially eligible, and is applying, for KidsCare
- An applicant who meets any of the following criteria:
 Is currently enrolled with AHCCCS

Screens potentially eligible for the <u>Medical Expense Deduction</u> (MD) category

One-e-App Health-e-Arizona submits new MA applications ONLY to AHCCCS when ALL of the following apply:

- A child applicant screens potentially eligible and is applying for Title XIX MA
- An applicant screens potentially eligible and is applying for KidsCare
- No one on the application is currently enrolled with AHCCCS
- No one on the application screens potentially eligible for MD When this occurs, the AHCCCS KidsCare staff completes the following:
- Reviews the applications to determine whether any of the applicants meet the following MA expedite criteria:

Hospitalized

Pregnant

Treat and Release

A report of these applications is forwarded to Research & Analysis (R&A) via e-mail. (See R&A KidsCare MA Referrals)

 Completes the KidsCare determination. When eligible, KidsCare MA is approved for all applicants, including the following:

Applicants who screened potentially eligible and are applying for Title XIX MA

Applicants forwarded to R&A for an MA expedite determination

When the KidsCare eligibility is determined, the application is submitted to FAA to complete the Title XIX determination, as follows:

- New MA only applications are automatically registered to the R&A Unit site code through the ACE - AZTECS interface, and the information is autopopulated into AZTECS. (See <u>R&A</u> <u>KidsCare MA Referrals</u>)
- R&A forwards applications with open or pending programs to the local office that serves the participant's residential ZIP Code. R&A transfers the Health-e-Arizona application in One-e-App to the local office. (See <u>FAA Kidscare Responsibilities</u>)
 - Renewal applications are forwarded to the <u>R&A Unit</u> for processing. (See <u>R&A KidsCare MA Referrals</u>)

The date of application is the date the KidsCare application was received at R&A from AHCCCS.

 The R&A Unit prints the application and verification documents from the AHCCCS imaging system, and <u>uploads(g)</u> them into <u>OnBase(g)</u>, within two <u>workdays(g)</u>.
