.06 Homeless Receiving Notices

A homeless participant's mail can be sent to a friend's address, but it is important that their name be added to the address at the United States Post Office. Otherwise, the mail may be returned and benefits may be stopped.

A homeless participant can also sign up for a PO Box or General Delivery Service with a United States Post (USPS) Office.

The participant must complete the <u>USPS form</u> and take the form and a valid ID to a General Delivery location (See <u>AZ General Delivery</u> <u>Locations.pdf</u>). The mail will be held at the General Delivery location for 30 days. The participant must request an extension from the General Delivery location every 30 days.
