

H Domestic Violence Emergency Shelters - NA

Domestic violence emergency shelters are defined as public or private nonprofit residential facilities. The facilities serve victims of family violence.

Domestic violence emergency shelters may serve other homeless participants and nonparticipants. However, a portion of the facility must be set aside on a long term basis to serve domestic violence victims.

A woman or a man who enters a shelter may have changed their Social Security number or name. When this is discovered, see [Enumeration Overview](#).
