H Shelters for Battered Women and Children - FS

Shelters for Battered Women and Children are defined as public or private nonprofit residential facilities. The facilities serve women and their children who are victims of family violence.

Shelters for battered women and children may serve other homeless participants and nonparticipants. However, a portion of the facility must be set aside on a long term basis to serve only battered women and children.

WARNING

Federal law does not include adult male victims of family violence in the provisions of this section.

A woman who enters a shelter may have changed her SSN or name. When this is discovered, see **Enumeration Overview**.
