## C Intent to Remain

Intent to remain is defined to include all of the following:

- The applicant considers Arizona their permanent home.
- The applicant has established residency in Arizona.
- The applicant has <u>abandoned residency</u> in another state or country.

## **NA EXCEPTION**

Intent to remain does not apply to NA.

## MA WARNING

Once Arizona residency has been established, the participant is considered a resident until the day they leave Arizona to establish residency in another state or country.

An applicant or participant who has established Arizona residency may state their intent to move on a future date. When eligible, approve the MA. Set an alert on EWAL to correspond to the potential move to verify continued residency.

When it is verified that the participant no longer meets the MA residency requirements, key RS in the DENIAL CLOSURE REASON field on MADA.

There is no durational time limit requirement for living in Arizona. No durational time limit means either of the following:

- An applicant may meet Arizona residency requirements on the day they move to Arizona. (See Example <u>Intent to Remain 1</u>)
- An applicant may be living in Arizona, but does not meet Arizona residency requirements. (See Example Intent to Remain 2)
