C Verification of Identity

REVISION 18 (10/01/11 - 12/31/11)

Accept any document that establishes the applicant's identity. Acceptable documents include, but are not limited to the following:

- Birth certificate
- Citizenship and immigration documents
- Driver's license
- Family census card
- ID card from health benefits or another assistance or social service program
- School ID
- Wage stubs
- Work ID
- Voter registration card
- Other reasonable written sources

Do not accept consular identification cards that are issued by a foreign government as a valid form of identity verification.

NA EXCEPTION

Request alternate forms of identity verification other than a consular identification card. Accept the consular identification card when it is the participant's ONLY form of identity verification.

When documents are not available, use a <u>collateral verification</u> when possible.

MA EXCEPTION

See <u>Identity Verification MA</u> for acceptable documents to use when verifying identity for proof of U.S. citizenship.
