A Citizenship Verification for CA or FS

U.S. citizenship is verified when the applicant's place of birth is within the U.S. or its territories, and all of the following are true:

- A claim of citizenship is consistent with statements made by the applicant on the application or previous applications.
- A claim of citizenship is consistent with information previously received from another source.

Appropriate documents are required to prove citizenship when either of the following occurs:

- The application indicates the applicant was born outside the U.S. or its territories, yet the applicant claims to be a citizen.
- There are inconsistencies regarding the applicant's place of birth.
