## .04 Victim of Severe Trafficking

A victim of severe human trafficking is admitted into the U.S. under the Trafficking Victims Protection Act (TVPA) of 2000.

This noncitizen is potentially eligible for benefits for a period of seven years from the date that their status is granted.

## MA EXCEPTION

The seven year period does not apply. There is no maximum time limit.

Applicants are potentially eligible for benefits regardless of any later change in their status. (See <u>LPR Eligibility</u>)

These applicants will have one of the following USCIS documents:

- I-94 with a T visa or Derivative T visa (T, T-2, T-3, T-4, or T-5).
- Passport, with a T visa or Derivative T visa (T, T-2, T-3, T-4, or T-5).
- I-797, Notice of Action, with a T visa or Derivative T visa (T, T-2, T-3, T-4, or T-5).
