.08 Conditional Entrant

A conditional entrant was granted conditional entry into the U.S. before April 1, 1980, pursuant to Section 203(a)(7) of the INA.

Conditional entrants are potentially eligible for benefits regardless of any later change in their status. (See LPR Eligibility)

These applicants normally have one of the following USCIS documents:

- <u>I-94</u> with the words, ADMITTED AS A REFUGEE -CONDITIONAL ENTRY under Section 203(a)(7) of the INA.
- <u>I-688B</u> with a provision of law code 274a.12(a)(3).
- <u>I-766</u> with A3.
