A Qualified Noncitizens

A qualified noncitizen is potentially eligible for CA, NA, and full services MA.

Key the following for qualified noncitizens who are eligible for benefits:

- IN in the PT field on SEPA
- EA in the CI field on IDCI

NOTE Use the Noncitizen Desk Aid (FAA-1261A) to assist in determining the correct noncitizen status.

EXCEPTION

Key the following codes in the CI field on IDCI for the following eligible qualified noncitizens:

- EF when the participant is a qualified noncitizen who is eligible for NA, but does not meet <u>LPR Eligibility</u> for CA or MA. Keying EF allows potential eligibility for NA, a <u>Federal Emergency</u> <u>Services</u> determination for MA, and ineligibility for CA (when DI is keyed in the PT field on SEPA).
- RE when the participant is determined eligible for <u>Refugee</u> <u>Cash Assistance</u> (RCA).

The types of qualified noncitizens are any of the following:

- Lawful Permanent Resident (LPR)
- <u>Asylee</u>
- Refugee or Amerasian
- Victim of Severe Trafficking
- Noncitizen Paroled into the U.S.
- Noncitizen Whose Deportation is Withheld
- Cuban or Haitian Entrant
- Conditional Entrant
- Abused or Battered Noncitizen
- Indefinite Detainee

- <u>Continuously Residing</u> MA
- Disabled Noncitizen
- <u>Military Connection</u>
