B Non-Sponsored Lawful Permanent Resident

A non-sponsored Lawful Permanent Resident (LPR) is a noncitizen given permission to permanently live and work in the U.S. and has not been sponsored through USCIS by an individual or an organization.

These individuals usually enter the U.S. in a temporary status.

A non-sponsored LPR must meet at least one of the additional requirements listed below to be potentially eligible for CA, NA, or full service MA:

- <u>Five Years Lawful Residency</u> (All programs)
- Prior Qualified Status (All programs)
- <u>Military Connection</u> (All programs)
- Continuous Residency (CA, MA)
- <u>Under Age 18</u> (NA)
- Permanently Disabled (NA)
- 40 Quarter Requirement (NA)
