06 CA Family Benefit Cap Period (FBCP) - Overview

A Family Benefit Cap Period (FBCP) is a period of 60 consecutive months assigned to parents and specified relatives who apply and receive CA for a dependent child. (See <u>Parent's 60 Month FBCP</u>)

WARNING

FBCP policy applies only to CA.

This policy is designed to encourage parents to be responsible and accountable for their family.

EXCEPTION

A child born before November 01, 1995, or before the start date of the parent's FBCP is not a Benefit Capped (BC) child.

FBCP policy does not apply to <u>Tribal CA</u> or <u>RCA</u> participants.

The following determines whether a child is subject to the FBCP:

- Parent's 60 Month FBCP
- Determining Whose FBCP to Use
- Benefit Capped Children
- FBCP Exempt Children

AZTECS calculates and displays the FBCP and displays on WERE and CLPR.

WERE and CLPR display the start and end dates of the FBCP for the parent or specified relative.

NOTE The FBCPs of other states are not applied to the FBCP in Arizona.
