.04 Geographic Exemption

REVISION 45 (01/01/17 - 12/31/17)

Participants who reside in a geographically exempt area are exempt from the ABAWD work requirements. This applies to participants who reside in the following geographically exempt areas:

- All American Indian Reservations (regardless of where they are located)
- Apache Junction (all counties)
- All Arizona counties

EXCEPTION

The following counties are not geographically exempt:

- Maricopa (except Apache Junction and for any initial application received 01/01/16 or later. Ongoing cases are potentially countable beginning with the January 2016 benefit month.)
- Pima (any initial or renewal application received 04/01/16 or after, for the benefit month beginning April 2016. For renewal applications, months are countable beginning with the client's first renewal after April 2016.)
- Yavapai (any initial or renewal application received 07/01/16 or after, for the benefit month beginning July 2016. For renewal applications, months are countable beginning with the client's first renewal after July 2016.)
 - NOTE All American Indian Reservations are geographically exempt regardless of where they are located, except the Yavapai-Prescott Indian reservation. For the Yavapai-Prescott Indian reservation, ABAWD countable months will begin with any initial application received 01/01/17 or after. For renewal applications, months are countable beginning with the client's first renewal month for the first renewal application submitted after 01/01/17.
