## Q TPEP Extension

REVISION 42 (06/01/16 - 07/31/16)

Budgetary units may be granted a one-time three month extension for TPEP at the <u>Expiration of the TPEP Six Month Limit</u>. The three-month extension period must be paid in three consecutive payments.

The budgetary unit is eligible for the TPEP three-month extension when all of the following apply:

- The Jobs Program notifies FAA that the household meets the conditions for the extension.
- The budgetary unit meets all other <u>TPEP eligibility</u> requirements.
- The three-month period immediately follows the end of the 6month TPEP period.

The Jobs Program sends an email to <a href="FAACHANGE@azdes.gov">FAACHANGE@azdes.gov</a> when the conditions are met for the TPEP extension.

When the extension approval is received, upload the information to the case and create an ACTS Alert.

(Use the OT Pre-defined ACTS Alert for TPEP extension approvals.)

The email from the Jobs Program will include one of the following extension reasons:

Voc Ed

A parent is enrolled in a vocational educational training program which can be completed within the three-month extension period.

Job Ofr

A parent has a bona fide offer of employment that will begin within the three-month extension period.

Wk Exp

A parent is in a work experience activity and the Jobs Program expects the parent to be hired within the three-month extension period.

Wk Rq Nm

The two-parent work requirement was not met during the sixmonth period, and good cause was established, as determined by the Jobs Program, for one or more months.
