## .08 Real Property - Land on a Reservation

REVISION 05 (07/01/08 - 09/30/08)

Land on a reservation, is NOT COUNTABLE as a resource. This includes the following:

- Land jointly held with the tribe
- Land that CAN NOT be sold without the approval of the Department of Interior's Bureau of Indian Affairs

## NA EXCEPTION

Land on a reservation is COUNTABLE as a resource when BOTH of the following apply:

- The land is owned solely by the participant
- The land can be sold without the approval of the Department of Interior's Bureau of Indian Affairs

## **MA EXCEPTION**

Resources apply to the MD category only.
