

## C Babysitting

Income received from babysitting is countable.

Babysitting income may be considered [wages and salaries](#) or [self-employment](#). FAA staff must explore whether the babysitting income meets the [self-employment definition](#).

When expenses are incurred, see [Allowable Business Expenses](#).

Key BA in the INCOME TYPE field on SEEI.

When the self-employment definition is not met, consider another type of [earned income](#).

When a participant reports income from the Child Care Stabilization Grant (CCSG). (See [FAA4.J05F](#) titled Child Care Stabilization Grant.)
