.14 Indian Gaming Industry Per Capita Disbursements

REVISION 15 (01/01/11 – 03/31/11)

Indian Gaming Industry per capita disbursements are considered income in the month received. These funds are COUNTABLE.

Any amount remaining in a following month is a countable resource. (See Indian Gaming - LIAS)

Key Indian Gaming Industry per capita disbursements in the INC TYPE field on UNIC as IG OT for CA and NA and IG MA for MA.

EXCEPTION

The Indian Gaming Industry per capita disbursement funds placed in an inaccessible trust by the tribe for either of the following are NOT COUNTABLE:

- Child 18 years of age and younger
- Incapacitated adult with a guardian or conservator

(See <u>Trust Funds</u> for additional policy)

Key the OX Unearned Income Code in the INC TYPE field on UNIC.

MA EXCEPTION

Indian Gaming Industry per capita disbursement funds received as a continuous source of income, are COUNTABLE for MA. (See Example <u>Continuous Source of Income</u>)

When the payment recurs at a predictable interval, <u>convert</u> to a monthly amount for the period of time it is intended to cover.
