.01 Countable Support - CA or MA

AZTECS counts the gross child or medical support payments received when any of the following apply:

- The payment is intended for a child included in the budgetary unit.
- The child for whom support is intended is ineligible for CA due to failure or refusal to comply with a <u>CA eligibility requirement</u>.
- The child for whom support is intended is ineligible for CA cash due to <u>Unwed Minor Parent</u> policy.
- The child for whom support is intended is no longer in the home and the support is retained by the budgetary unit. (See <u>Third Party Beneficiary Payments</u>)
- The payment is intended for a child coded IN for MA (countable) and BC for CA (not countable for CA).
- The payment is paid or returned to the participant from DCSE.
- The payment is paid or returned to the participant from a private collection agency.
- The budgetary unit receives support payments after approval and does not turn in the payments to DCSE. (See <u>Not</u> <u>Surrendered Support</u>)

NOTE The participant is allowed to keep child support issued by DCSE for a <u>Benefit Capped child</u>.

Child support payments issued through DCSE that are in excess of the CA benefit amount.

Child support payments issued through DCSE to a CA participant during their three month Grant Diversion time frame.

MA EXCEPTION

AZTECS automatically calculates a \$50 child support deduction for each child receiving child support income.
