.02 Not Countable Support - CA or MA

AZTECS does not count support payments received when any of the following apply:

 The payment is intended for a child in the home who is not included in the budgetary unit.

NOTE This includes children who are not included due to lack of deprivation, or as a recipient of SSI.

- The payments are small nonrecurring <u>gifts</u> that do not exceed \$30 per quarter, per child, from an absent parent.
- The payment is a <u>vendor payment</u>, such as rent or mortgage paid directly to the landlord or mortgagor by the absent parent. An <u>In-kind benefit(g)</u> provided by the absent parent is also not countable.
- The payment is intended for a <u>Benefit Capped child</u> in a CA budgetary unit (the payment is countable for MA).
- Child support payments are assigned and retained by DCSE when CA is approved and continues while CA remains in an OPEN status. (See Example <u>Child or Medical Support 1</u> and Example <u>Child or Medical Support 2</u>)

EXCEPTION

Child support payments issued through DCSE to CA participants during the three month Grant Diversion time frame are COUNTABLE.

 Do not count support arrearages. Arrearage payments are for prior months and are countable as a resource. (See <u>Lump</u> <u>Sum</u> – LIAS)

MA EXCEPTION

A nonrecurring lump sum arrearage payment is COUNTABLE as income in the month received. Count the unspent portion as a resource in the following month. Resources are COUNTABLE in the MD category only.
