.04 Not Countable Support - NA

AZTECS does not count support payments when the payment is intended and keyed for a child in the home who is not included in the budgetary unit.

EXCEPTION

The income of children who are <u>nonqualified noncitizens</u> must be prorated to the remaining budgetary unit participants. AZTECS prorates the income of the child when their code in the PT field on SEPA is DI. (See <u>NA Special Considerations</u>)

When the court has ordered support payments be paid to a third party instead of the budgetary unit, the payment is considered a <u>vendor</u> <u>payment</u>. Do not count any amount in excess of the court order.

Do not count child support arrearages as income. Arrearage payments are ALWAYS for prior months and are countable as a resource. (See <u>Lump Sum</u> - LIAS)

Do not count nonrecurring monies from an absent parent that do not exceed \$30 per quarter, per child.
