.03 30 Days After the Date of Interview

When the participant receives income after the interview and voluntarily provides verification, day one of the 30-day period is the date the participant received the most current income. (See Example 30-Day Period-After)

The 30 days of the most current information for any month in this situation can be determined using the <u>AZTECS Monthly Production Schedule</u> (AMPS) as follows:

- Use the Income Request Period Calendar (mm) in AMPS for the appropriate month.
- Locate the date the participant received the most current income in the INTERVIEW DATE column.
- Advance to the next day in the column to locate the day after the date the participant received the most current income.
- Locate the date that displays in the 30 DAYS PRIOR column next to the day after the date the participant received the most current income. This is day 30 of the 30 days of the most current information.
