## .02 Deemed Income of a Parent of a Minor Parent

The income of a parent of an unwed minor parent is either deemed or counted in full to a minor parent's CA budgetary unit. (See <a href="UMP">UMP</a> <a href="Living With Parent or Relative">Living With Parent or Relative</a>)

When an adult parent's income must be deemed, key DP in the AF PT field on SEPA next to the adult parent.

Key the <u>deemed income deductions</u> on DEID.

Key all income on the appropriate income screens.

Income is not deemed to a minor parent who is an SSI recipient.

The income of the parent and spouse of the parent is deemed to the minor parent's CA budgetary unit, when the minor parent is disqualified and coded DI or DF on SEPA.

When more than one minor parent lives in the home and each applies for their own children, divide the income of the parent as follows:

- Complete a Cash Assistance Deeming Budget Record (<u>FA-201</u>) to determine the net income after deducting the cost of employment (COE).
- Equally divide the net income between the minor parents.
- Key each minor parent's share on UNIN.
- Key the <u>deemed income deductions</u> on DEID.
