.01 Shelter and Utility Allowance

AZTECS calculates the shelter and utility allowance based on expenses keyed on EXNS.

The monthly shelter and utility allowance is the amount that exceeds 50% of the budgetary unit's net income (after all other deductions have been allowed) not to exceed the <u>maximum shelter deduction</u> <u>amount</u>.

EXCEPTION

A budgetary unit that contains an <u>elderly or disabled participant</u> is not subject to a maximum shelter deduction. The budgetary unit is eligible for excess shelter without a maximum deduction, even when the only elderly or disabled participant is disqualified due to any of the following:

- Felony drug conviction (DF)
- Fleeing felon (DF)
- NA Employment & Training (NA E&T) noncompliance (DE)
- <u>IPV</u> sanction (DF)

A budgetary unit that contains an elderly or disabled participant who is disqualified for any other reason is subject to the maximum shelter deduction.

A homeless budgetary unit is eligible for the greater amount of either the excess shelter deduction or the <u>NA homeless shelter deduction</u>.
