03 CA Work Programs

Jobs is the CA work program in Arizona. Jobs encourages and helps families obtain employment. Parents are expected to accept responsibility for the support of their children by preparing for, accepting, and retaining employment.

All CA participants who are included in the CA benefits are mandatory Jobs participants, unless the participant meets <u>CA Jobs exemptions</u>.

The following are Jobs programs that serve CA participants:

- <u>Jobs BASIC</u>. Referred to as Jobs, this program serves all CA participants except those served by any of the other Jobs programs listed. For Jobs office locations, see <u>Jobs office</u>.
 - NOTE See the TANF Refugee Program (TARP) for the CA work program available for certain refugees.
- TPEP Jobs. The Two-Parent Employment Program (TPEP) serves two-parent budgetary units in which the <u>primary wage earning</u> parent (PWE) is unemployed or underemployed. TPEP services are time limited and are provided on a state-wide basis. For TPEP office locations, see <u>TPEP office</u>.
- Tribal NEW. Several Arizona Indian tribes each operate their own work program, Native Employment Works (NEW). Each Tribal NEW office serves all of the CA eligible Native American Indians living within the geographical area specified by the tribe as its work program area. Each Tribal NEW office serves participants, regardless of the participant's tribal affiliation. (For areas served, see Service Delivery Area)
- JobStart. Jobstart is a subsidized, time-limited employment program. It allows participants to work for a private sector employer. The program replaces the participant's CA and FS benefits with subsidized paid employment.
