A CA Jobs Program Preliminary Orientation (JPPO)

REVISION 14 (10/01/10 – 12/31/10)

The Jobs Program Preliminary Orientation (JPPO) provides new CA participants information about the following:

- The Jobs Program
- Jobs participation requirements
- Jobs work and training activities
- Jobs supportive services
- CA benefits are decreased when participants fail to cooperate with the Jobs Program requirements after CA approval

ALL new CA participants who are CA Jobs mandatory referrals are required to complete a JPPO before CA approval. (See <u>CA Jobs</u> <u>mandatory referrals</u>)

EXCEPTION

The JPPO requirement does not apply to the following:

- Two Parent Employment Program (TPEP)
- Salt River Pima Maricopa Indian Community (SRPMIC) Tribal TANF Program
- Pascua Yaqui Tribal TANF Program
 - NOTE The Pascua Yaqui TANF Program has its own preapproval compliance requirement.
- Grant Diversion participants
