## .02 NA E&T LP Selection Rules- More Than One Adult And A Child

The PI designates the NA E&T LP when both of the following apply:

- There is more than one adult in the budgetary unit
- One of the adults has a child, or parental control of a child, under age 18 living in the budgetary unit.

When this occurs, the following apply:

- Adult is defined as being at least age 18, or when under age 18 is not under parental control(g).
- The budgetary unit must agree on the NA E&T LP.
- The NA E&T LP is not required to be the adult with children.
- When the adults cannot agree on the NA E&T LP, designate the NA E&T LP and inform the PI of the designation.
- Once designated, the participant remains the NA E&T LP until the next renewal or until a change in budgetary unit living arrangements results in there being no adult with children in the budgetary unit.
