F AHCCCS Medical Cost Recovery

AHCCCS is entitled to recover their costs incurred in providing medical care when another party is found responsible for these costs. This may occur, but is not limited to, the following incurred medical expenses:

- A participant was injured
- A participant was involved in an accident
- A participant was involved in medical malpractice

There may be evidence that an MA participant has been injured or involved in an accident within the past three years and another party is or may be responsible for resulting costs. When this occurs, complete the Injury/Malpractice Referral (FAA-1147A) form. When the participant is determined eligible for MA, send the FAA-1147A to the Internal Operations Unit.

NOTE Place a copy of the FAA-1147A in the <u>case file(g)</u> with the current application.

The types of coverage include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Accidental death and dismemberment insurance
- Automobile liability or medical insurance
- General liability insurance
- Worker's Compensation

When the information is not available, indicate UNKNOWN on the FAA-1147A and submit the form to the Internal Operations Unit. Do not delay the eligibility determination.
