B Expanded Categorical Eligibility

REVISION 45 (01/01/17 - 12/31/17)

Expanded categorical eligibility exists when all of the following apply to the budgetary unit:

- Gross income does not exceed <u>185% of the current federal</u> poverty level (FPL)
- The NA budgetary unit does not meet <u>Basic categorical</u> <u>eligibility</u> requirements
- The budgetary unit does not have a participant coded DF on SEPA due to a disqualification. (See <u>NA Participants Keyed</u> <u>as DF</u>)
- The resources of all participants coded DI on SEPA are not over the NA resource limit

NOTE Resources from a DI participant count in full

WARNING

A participant in the budgetary unit may meet the NA definition of elderly or disabled. In this situation both of the following apply:

The budgetary unit receives <u>special considerations</u>. (See <u>Elderly or</u> <u>Disabled NA Requirements.)</u>

Expanded categorical eligibility applies to the budgetary unit only when the budgetary unit's gross income does not exceed 185% of the current FPL and no participant is coded DF on SEPA.

AZTECS automatically considers an NA Expanded categorically eligible budgetary unit to have met the following NA eligibility factors:

- Resources
- Gross and net income tests
