03 Prospective Eligibility for MA - Overview

Participants can be eligible for MA when they are prospectively eligible as calculated by AZTECS. To be prospectively eligible, participants must meet <u>MA eligibility factors</u>.

Complete the following to determine whether participants are prospectively eligible for MA based on the income limits:

- Use the countable income for the month being determined. (See <u>Budgeting Income</u>, <u>Budgeting Self Employment</u>, and <u>Budgeting Educational Income</u> for policy and procedures regarding countable income)
- Use allowable expenses for the month being determined. (See <u>Budgeting Expenses</u> for policy and procedures regarding expenses and deductions. (See <u>MD Expenses</u> for the MD category) AZTECS displays each participant's MA category based on the <u>MA eligibility</u> factors for the category.

Participants are considered to be prospectively eligible based on income standards. Eligibility exists when the total countable income meets the limit established for the following categories:

- Participants in <u>1931</u> must pass the following income tests:
 <u>MA Income Maximum Standard</u>
 <u>MA Income Standard</u>
- S.O.B.R.A. participants must pass the appropriate <u>Federal</u> <u>Poverty Level</u> (FPL).

AZTECS displays the details of the results of the determinations for the MA categories as follows:

- For 1931 budgetary units, on 31CD
- For Individual MA, on MACD
- For Medical Expense Deduction (MD), on MAMD
