Send the appropriate notice using one of the following time frames:

 When a determination results in an approval, send an <u>approval</u> notice by one of the following:

The 45th calendar day from the date of application for new applications.

When the determination results in an approval, send an approval notice by one of the following for NA new applications:

- The 30th calendar day from the date of application.
- The seventh calendar day from the date of application for expedited NA.

Prior to the end of the current approval period for renewal applications.

• When a determination results in a denial, send a <u>denial notice</u> by the 45th calendar day from the date of application.

NA EXCEPTION

When the determination results in a denial, send a denial notice by the 30th calendar day from the date of application.

 When a determination results in benefits being stopped, send a <u>closure notice</u> allowing for one of the following:

Adequate notice

NOAA

NA EXCEPTION

NA closures require Adequate notice, NOAA or No Notice.

NOAA is not required when denying an NA renewal application.
