## D Categorical Eligibility Application Calculation

AZTECS does not compare the income of a categorically eligible FS budgetary unit against the <u>Gross</u> and <u>Net</u> Income Standards. However, benefits are calculated based on <u>FS income criteria</u>. Consider the following:

- When the budgetary unit is categorically eligible for FS benefits, follow normal processing procedures.
- All FS categorically eligible one and two-person budgetary units are eligible for at least \$10.

## **FS EXCEPTION**

FS categorically eligible one and two-person budgetary units are NOT eligible for at least \$10 when the allotment is reduced to less than \$10 as a result of <u>FS proration</u>. (See <u>Eligible No Pay Special</u> <u>Keying Procedures</u>)

• Place a budgetary unit in an eligible no pay status when they do not receive benefits for one of the following reasons:

Budgetary units whose benefits are reduced to less than \$10 as a result of <u>FS proration</u>.

Budgetary units with three or more participants who are eligible for zero benefits. (See <u>Eligible-No Pay Special Keying</u> <u>Procedures</u>)
