E Food Stamp Budgetary Units In Eligible No Pay Status

Apply the following to <u>FS categorically eligible budgetary units</u> in <u>FS</u> eligible no pay status:

 A budgetary unit remains in eligible no pay status until one of the following occurs:

The budgetary unit reports a change making it eligible for benefits.

A change causes the budgetary unit to lose its <u>categorical</u> <u>eligibility</u> status.

The budgetary unit becomes ineligible for a reason other than income or resources.

The approval period ends.

 When a reported change makes the budgetary unit eligible for benefits, when currently in an FS eligible no pay status, apply the following:

An interview is not required.

Eligibility begins the month following the month the change is reported. (See <u>Benefit Increases-Overview</u>)

Verify the information BEFORE effecting the change.

See <u>Effecting Benefit Increases</u>)

- The budgetary unit is subject to <u>reporting requirements</u> and must comply with all FS eligibility requirements.
- Otherwise mandatory participants are subject to <u>E&T Work</u>
 <u>Program</u> requirements.
- The budgetary unit may submit an application for renewal. Treat the renewal like any other budgetary unit renewal.
